FLAG FOOTBALL PROGRAM

Teams will be formed and coached by parent volunteer coaches. The league typically plays a 7 v 7 format.

Practices will begin the week of August 26 with games starting the week of September 10.

Games and/or practices will be held on Monday, Tuesday, and/or Thursday evenings depending on the schedule with other communities.

WHO: GRADES 1-6

WHEN: August 26 – October 10

WHERE: SCORE 4-PLEX – some traveling is required for game play

TIME: 6:00-8:00 p.m. (Exact practice/game schedule will be emailed out at a later date)

FEE: \$78.00 (includes jersey – all jerseys are new this year)

YOUTH VOLLEYBALL PROGRAM

Teams will be formed and coached by parks and recreation staff and parent/volunteer coaches. Players will learn fundamental volleyball skills and incorporate them into game play.

The program will typically be held on Tuesday and Thursday evenings (some Monday practices will be scheduled due to gym availability), 3-4 graders will likely be from 6:00-7:00 p.m. and 5-6 graders from 7:00-8:00 p.m., depending on registrations. The first two weeks of the program will be practices only.
