



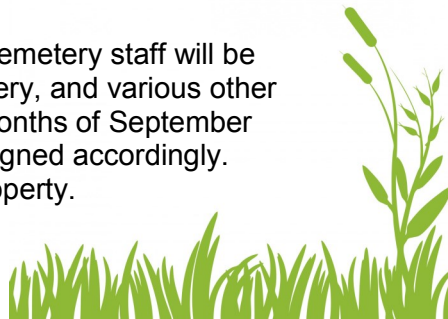
Legion Auxiliary Dinner

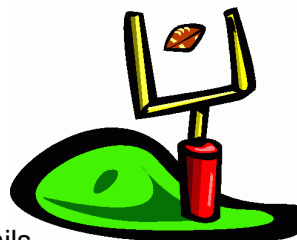

Get caught reading your favorite banned book! Stop in this week to take a mugshot with your favorite controversial read.

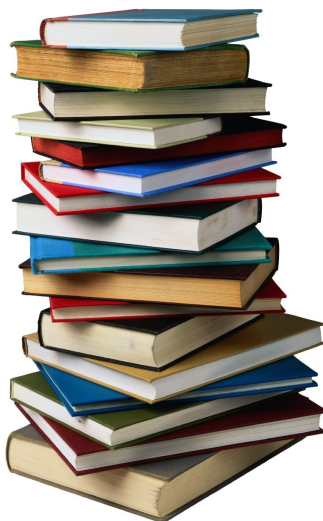
Danny Steiber: The Barn Quilt Guy

Utility payments are due upon receipt and considered late after the 15th of the month. There is a drop box near the front door of City Hall and payments are collected each day at 5:00 p.m. Any payment dropped in the box after 5:00 p.m. is considered the next day's business. If the 15th falls on Saturday or Sunday, the box is emptied at 8:00 a.m. on the Monday following and any payments made after 8:00 a.m. are considered late. The 15th is not a postmark deadline and all payments received after the 15th are considered late.
