# NEVADA CITY COUNCIL - MONDAY, JANUARY 26, 2015 6:00 P.M.

#### 1. Call to Order

The City Council of the City of Nevada, Iowa, met for a regular meeting in the Council Chambers located at City Hall, 1209 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Nevada, Iowa. Mayor Lynn Lathrop convened the meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, January 26, 2015, pursuant to the rules of the Council. The agenda was posted on the official bulletin board in compliance with the open meeting law.

#### 6. OLD BUSINESS

A. Ordinance No. 983 (2014/2015): An Ordinance amending the Zoning Map of the City of Nevada, Iowa, by amending the Zoning Classification of parcels of land owned by Cary and Sherri Martin and located within the corporate limits of the City of Nevada, Iowa from "DC" (Downtown Commercial) District to "R2" (Residential, Single and Two Family Dwelling) District 2 (2<sup>nd</sup> Reading)

## 8. REPORTS

Chris Clark reported on the Fire/EMS Board. Discussion regarding renovations, amount of volunteer hours, equipment purchase and training. Grants have been awarded for defibs and air packs.

## Elizabeth Hansen

- Brett Barker started the "Fill the Foyer Campaign". A meeting is scheduled for Thursday evening to decide how to distribute the overwhelming contributions.
- Community Betterment Committee will be meeting to review the City Hall Campus project and decide how to educate the community.
- The Senior Citizens Board, the Nevada Senior Community Center Board, along with a representative from Heartland, will meet to discuss participation of congregate meals that are served at the center.
- Hansen reminded council to be watching for the budget presentation materials on Friday. The budget workshop is Monday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6:00 p.m.
- Request was made for any changes to the Vision 2020 presentation.
- Dave Naughton called regarding a Downtown Revitalization meeting being held March 3 at 6:30 p.m. at the Talent Factory. If the majority of the council will be attending a notice needs to be posted. Consensus was there, so a notice will be posted.
- Iowa Architectural Foundation (Community Design Program) press release will be in the Journal on January 23<sup>rd</sup>. Anyone interested in serving on the committee is welcome to apply and needs to let the Mayor know.

Mayor Lathrop thanked Andy Kelly for stepping in at the last meeting while he was recovering. He is getting up to speed on his emails.

Shawn Cole reported he will be getting the new intern started. Ray Schwichtenberg thanked Cole for working on the drainage ditch repair.

Tim Hansen advised staff is working on spring/summer work while the weather is nice. Trimming trees at the cemetery and a lot of burials as well. Hansen thanked Cole for helping with the placement of rip rap material along the trail to help with erosion. Brian Hanson inquired about the ITC grant for SCORE and the scoreboards.

Mike Neal reported the water department had two big water main breaks and four staff members pulled an all nighter working on the break. He thanked Dave Harrison, Brad Tendall, Jamie Tendall and Shawn Ludwig. Andy Kelly commented the water department staff responds well with customers and work hard.

Ric Martinez advised he is going through the hiring process and hopes to have some new hires by the end of March.

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Kerin Wright reported administration has placed ads for the open position. Staff is working through the budget process.

Larry Stevens advised he has been working with Elizabeth Hansen on the CIP, moving some asphalt work up. A proposal will be forth coming. Hansen advised the scope/fee for the 2015 Asphalt Paving Project will be in the packet for next meeting.
